SUPERVISOR: Director of Family Services

GENERAL SUMMARY: This team helps our Family Services Department select the families that will continue in the Habitat program by visiting the current homes of applicants to ensure that they meet the requirement of need for better housing and also help us determine that they are willing to partner with us.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the Director of Family Services in determining if families are qualified to continue in the Habitat program
- Make home visits to applicant families (along with another team member), where you will talk with the family and help us determine they are willing to partner with Habitat Greenville, as well as look to see if they truly do need better housing
- Meet monthly with the team to discuss families, experiences, and make decisions on which families to recommend for the program

QUALIFICATIONS

- Strong people skills desired, especially the ability to read people beyond what they actually say
- Budgeting/financial experience and knowledge are helpful
- Ability to be accepting of low-income families, sometimes of a different background, social status, race, religion, etc than you

- The meetings are held the first Thursday of every month at the Century 21 Bob Capes Building on 333 Wade Hampton Blvd. at 1:00 pm
- Serve at least one year on the team
