The group will plan the project or activity (like painting old wineglasses, creating a picture collage out of a window frame, etc.), promote the event, invite attendees, and show up for a fun experience. Great opportunity for skilled volunteers or social groups looking to learn new skills or partner. Max 15 people.

Run a Repair & Refurbish Day

Most donated items just need a little TLC. By hosting a repair and refurbish day volunteers will sort, test, repair (if necessary) and clean items for display on the sales floor. This allows us to sell much better products for a maximized impact on our mission. Ideal opportunity for skilled volunteer groups looking to give back with their invaluable experience. Max 7 people.
